RESOLUTION NO. 30-2003

On motion presented by COUN. LORETA M. UYCOCO and unanimously seconded;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to approve Resolution No. 30-2003 containing therein Ordinance No. 3 S. 2003, to wit:

**ORDINANCE No. 3
SERIES 2003**

“AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PHILHEALTH CAPITATION FUND FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE OUTPATIENT CONSULTATION AND DIAGNOSTIC BENEFIT PACKAGE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION (PHILHEALTH) FOR QUALIFIED INDIGENT FAMILIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONCADA UNDER THE INDIGENT SECTOR COMPONENT OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (NHIP).”

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MONCADA, TARLAC IN SESSION ASSEMBLED;

WHEREAS, the Philippines Constitution declares as a state policy to provide its territorial and political subdivisions genuine and meaningful Local Autonomy to enable them to attain their fullest development as self-reliant communities and as effective partners in the attainment of national goal;

WHEREAS, the State likewise declares that the vesting of duty, responsibility and accountability in local government units (LGUs) shall be accompanied with provision for reasonably adequate resources to effectively carry out their functions;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of these constitutional mandates, Congress has mandated the implementation of the Indigent Sector Component of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) or the Medicare Para Sa Masa;

WHEREAS, the priority program is aimed at “setting into motion a meaningful health care financing and delivery mechanism anchored on local government;

WHEREAS, the Indigent Program of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) provides a mechanism to identify the qualified indigent families and to grant them membership to NHIP through full or partial government subsidies. It will enable them access to medical service in all NHIP accredited providers;

WHEREAS, the Body, considering the beneficent features of RA 7875 as it will vastly improve the over-all health status of the population and ultimately, their general quality of the life and rationalize the Municipal Government’s expenditure for health, collectively agreed to adopt the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) of the National Government;

WHEREAS, the creation of a PhilHealth Capitation Fund (PCF) is necessary to attain the purpose and objectives of the indigent Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to create a PhilHealth Capitation Fund from the proceeds of the outpatient consultation and diagnostic benefit package to be provided by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) for qualified indigent families of the Municipality of Moncada under the indigent sector component of the NHIP;

RESOLVED THAT, the use, management and disposition of the PhilHealth Capitation Fund shall be governed by the following rules:

1. The capitation amount shall be released on a quarterly basis by the Corporation under the following conditions:
 - 1.1 Initial release shall be subject to prior accreditation of the municipality-owned and manage Rural Health Units and the payment of premium contribution by the Municipal Government; and
 - 1.2 Succeeding releases of quarterly capitation shall be subject to the submission of required monitoring/evaluation reports, research and program development as provided for under the Implementing Guidelines of the Outpatient Consultation and Diagnostic Package and prior payment of premiums in case of quarterly mode of remittance.
2. The disposition of the PCF shall be governed by the following rules:
 - 2.1. The disbursement and liquidation of the PCF shall be in accordance with pertinent government accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
 - 2.2 A separate book of accounts shall be maintained by the local government unit; and

3.3 Only drugs listed in the Primary Medical Care Drugs of the Philippines National Drug Formulary, medical supplies and equipment necessary to carry out the delivery of the required services including referral fees and administrative cost not to exceed twenty percent (20%) of the capitation fund shall be charged to the PCF. The twenty percent administrative cost shall be divided among health personnel of the RHU, fifty percent (50%) of which shall accrue to the physician/s while the remaining fifty percent (50%) to the other personnel.

3. The Corporation may withhold the release of the subsequent quarterly PCFs due to any of the following:

3.1 Delay of non-payment of premium contribution.

3.2 Violation of government accounting and auditing rules and regulations on the disbursement and liquidation of the PCF; and

3.3 Non-submission of the required reports under item 1-2 hereof.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this Ordinance to the President of the Republic of the Philippines, HER EXCELLENCY GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO, the President and Chief Executive Officer of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation, MR. FRANCISCO DUQUE III and the HONORABLE MAYOR ESTELITA M. AQUINO for their information.
