**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MONCADA, TARLAC, THROUGH THE HONORABLE MAYOR ESTELITA M. AQUINO TO ENTER INTO A JOINT VENTURE AGREEMENT (JVA) WITH THE ENVIROKONSULT EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF SEPTAGE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM AND ESTABLISHMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A SEPTAGE TREATMENT PLANT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONCADA**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Government of Moncada is empowered by law to provide, among others, solid waste disposal system or environmental management system and services and facilities related to general hygiene and sanitation and infrastructure facilities intended primarily to service the needs of the residents of the municipality, including those which involve drainage and septage/sewerage services to protect the environment and people's health;

**WHEREAS**, the LGU does not have an adequate sewerage and septage system necessary to meet the needs of the community it serves, thereby posing a threat to human and environmental health;

**WHEREAS**, Section 7, par. 3 of R.A. No. 9275 or the Clean Water Act mandates the LGU to "appropriate the necessary land, including the required rights-of-way/road access to the land for the construction of the sewage and/or septage treatment facilities", and Section 7, par. 4 allows the LGU to "raise funds to subsidize necessary expenses for the operation and maintenance of sewerage treatment or septage facility servicing their area of jurisdiction through local property taxes and enforcement of a service fee system;"
